



Carbon-neutral mission

Trees For Life recently opened its new home at Brooklyn Park and launched its exciting program Carbon Neutral program last Friday. Environment Minister Gail Gago officiated the opening, made possible by a generous \$400,000 donation from charitable foundation CMV and further contribution from the State Government. The donation is the largest in Trees for Life's 54-year history. The expansion includes a dedicated nursery, seedling distribution centre, a base for volunteers and workshops, and expansive office space with on-site parking. The program is a major step towards helping combat climate change. It offers individuals, private corporations and government departments the opportunity to offset carbon dioxide produced by their vehicles and daily activities.
